

Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023

INFORMATION AND DATA DIRECTION [s. 500]

This is an information and data direction relating to information and data that licensed insurers and licensed self-insurers are required to provide to WorkCover WA in accordance with section 500 of the *Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023.*

The direction is effective 1 July 2024.

Policy and claim data

- Data and information relating to workers compensation policies and claims referred to in section 500(1)(a) of the Act must be provided to WorkCover WA in the form, manner and by any timeframes specified in WorkCover WA's *National Insurer Data Specification Guidelines* version 1.3, dated 10 May 2024, or as amended from time to time.
- 2. Medical (including diagnostic imaging services and workers compensation ancillary services), allied health services, workplace rehabilitation services, and permanent impairment assessor services must be coded as specified in WorkCover WA's *Service Fees and Codes Guidelines* version 1.0, dated 10 May 2024, or as amended from time to time.

Premium rates data

3. Data and information required by WorkCover WA to set recommended premium rates referred to in section 500(1)(e) of the Act must be provided in the form, manner and by due timeframes specified in WorkCover WA's *Premium Rates Data Guidelines* version 1.1, dated 10 May 2024, or as amended from time to time.
