



## **Compensation for Death of a Worker**

The Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023 (the WCIMA23) provides a claim process and compensation entitlements for dependants where a worker has died as a result of a work-related injury.

## Key Points

Act ref: Part 2 Division 10

- The WCIMA23 sets out the amount of compensation payable to dependants and the claims process to be followed when a worker dies as a result of a workplace injury.
- Compensation includes a lump sum payment for specified dependants, a weekly dependant child allowance, along with funeral expenses.
- The WCIMA23 confirms the status of unborn children of the worker at the time of the worker's death as dependants. The definition of 'child' and 'dependant' in the WCIMA23 ensures a child of a worker conceived before but born after a worker's death is eligible to receive compensation if they would have been dependent on the worker at the time of birth had the death not occurred.
- Claims for a workplace fatality must be made in the approved form published on the WorkCover WA website as CF4 – Workplace fatality compensation claim form.
