



# **Dispute Resolution**

The Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023 (WCIMA23) sets out the dispute resolution framework applicable to the Conciliation Service and Arbitration Service at WorkCover WA.

## **Key Points**

#### Act ref: Part 6

- Provisions for the establishment of the Conciliation Service and Arbitration Service are consolidated in Part 6 Division 2 of the WCIMA23.
- Conciliation is a pre-requisite for arbitration unless the dispute is certified unsuitable for conciliation by the Director.
- An application for an order on a claim by dependants of a worker who has died as a result of an injury from employment can proceed directly to arbitration without the need for conciliation.
- The Director has issued the Workers
  Compensation and Injury Management
  Conciliation Rules 2024 (the Conciliation
  Rules 2024) which set out the document
  lodgment and process requirements.
- The WCIMA23 provides for legal practitioners or authorised agents to represent a party at a conciliation conference or arbitration hearing.
- The definition of 'authorised agent' includes persons authorised by the Workers Compensation and Injury Management Regulations 2024 (the WCIMR24) to perform agent services and provides for a scheme for registered independent agents on a two-year transitional basis.

- The WCIMA23 permits an arbitrator to dismiss a proceeding for abuse of process, want of prosecution or other ground for dismissal specified in the Workers Compensation and Injury Management Arbitration Rules 2024 (the Arbitration Rules 2024). This may be on application by a party to the dispute or on the arbitrator's own initiative.
- The Registrar is authorised to publish any decision of an arbitrator and to limit the publication in any manner the Registrar considers appropriate.

### **Questions & Answers**

Q. What happens to dispute proceedings in progress under the *Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 1981 (WCIMA81)* on 1 July 2024?

**A.** The savings and transitional provisions in the *WCIMA23* provide for pending dispute proceedings and dispute decisions under the *WCIMA81*. Most active cases will proceed under the *WCIMA23* and transitional directions made by the CEO, Director or Registrar may apply in particular cases.
