First steps

What is workers compensation?

Workers compensation is financial compensation provided to workers who become injured or ill as a result of work.

This may include compensation to cover loss of earnings, medical expenses, permanent impairment, and workplace rehabilitation to assist you to return to work.

Who can make a claim?

Any worker who suffers a work related injury or disease requiring medical treatment or time off work is entitled to claim workers compensation, regardless of who was at fault.

- 1 Seek first aid and report the incident to your employer.



- 2 Visit a doctor of your choice and obtain a **First Certificate of Capacity**.



- 3 Fill in a **Workers Compensation Claim Form**.



- 4 Give the **First Certificate of Capacity** and **Workers Compensation Claim Form** to your employer, and keep copies for yourself.
