WorkCover WA is the government agency responsible for regulating and administering the workers compensation scheme in Western Australia



The scheme in Western Australia is designed to ensure workers who suffer a work-related injury or illness are compensated for lost earning, medical expenses, and other associated costs.

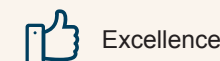
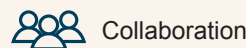
WorkCover WA regulates the scheme under the *Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023* (the Act), with the primary objective to ensure work-related injuries are actively managed to assist injured workers to achieve a safe and sustained return to work.

Role of WorkCover WA

- regulate and monitor service providers to ensure they comply with the Act
- provide information and education on all aspects of the scheme
- provide an independent dispute resolution service for workers compensation issues
- monitor employers to ensure they maintain current workers compensation insurance coverage for all workers
- manage processes related to workplace fatalities and assessment of permanent impairment claims.
